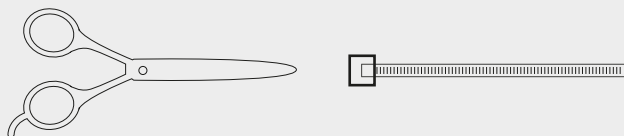




METAL FENCE INSTALLATION

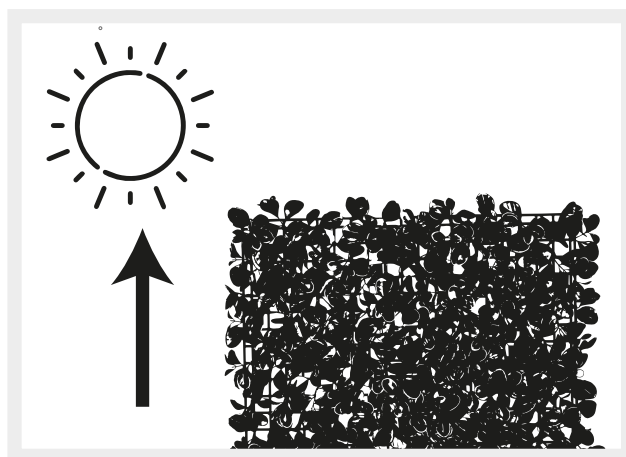
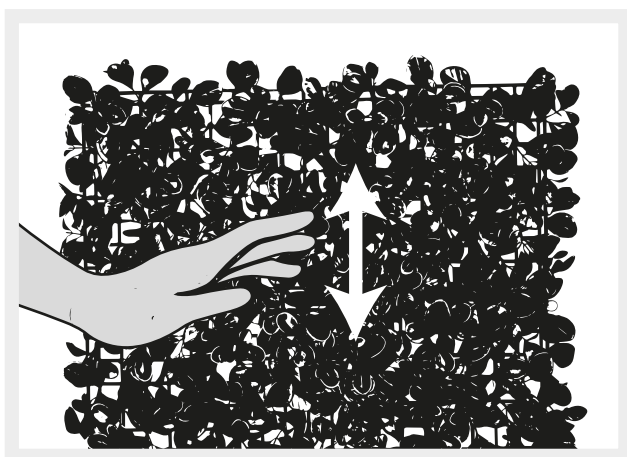
1. Scissors
2. Plastic zip ties



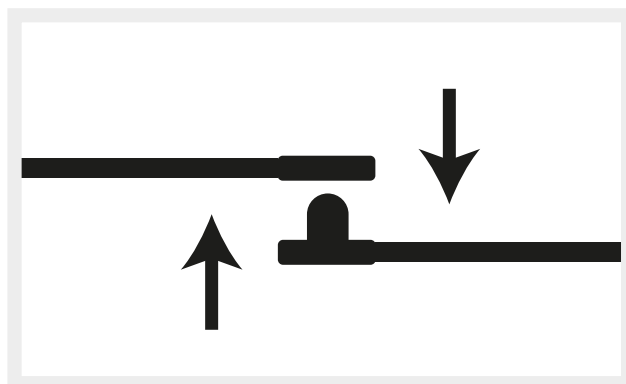
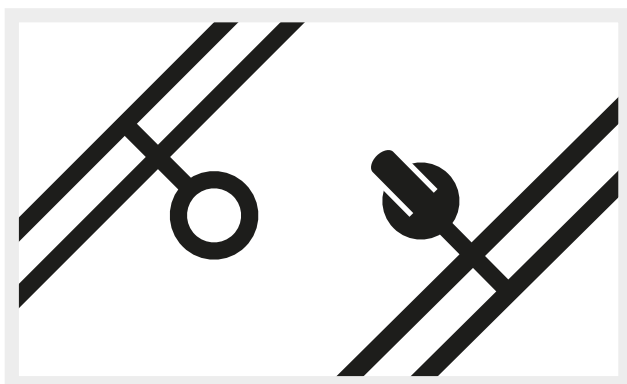
Installation

Step 1: Preparing for you installation

Open your box of Emerald Artificial Greenery and remove each panel and loosen the vegetation. Plants bloom towards the sun. Position your panels with the vegetation facing upwards for the most realistic look.

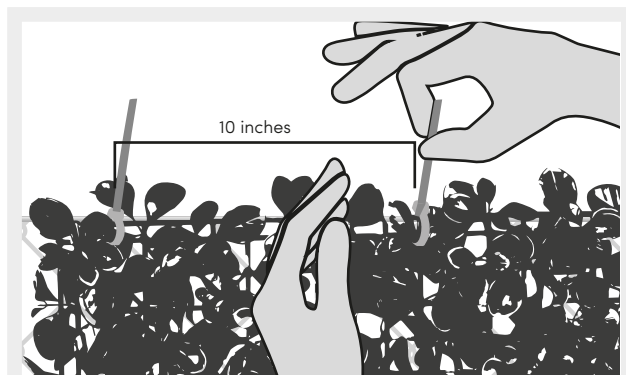
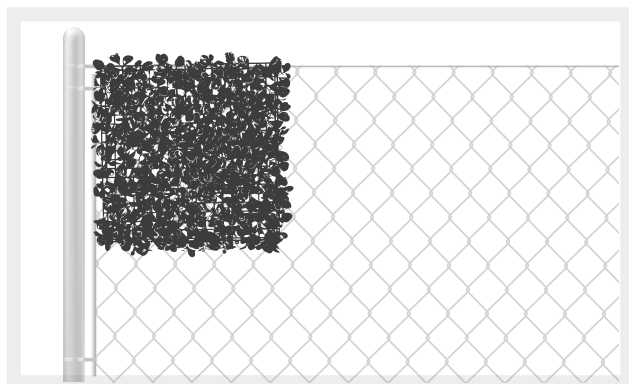


Step 2: Install your panels

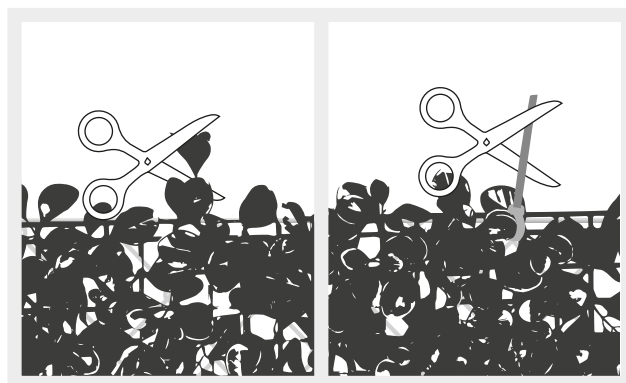
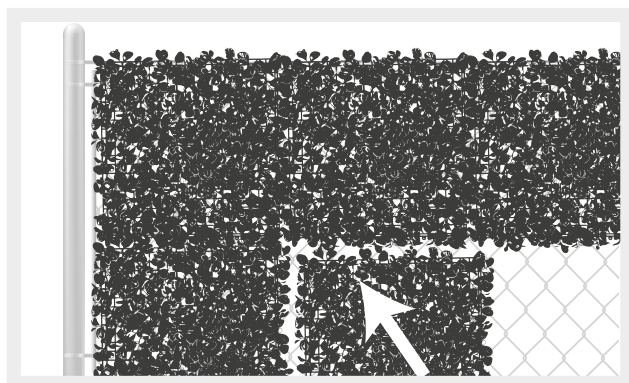


- Be careful when installing the panels; each panel has male and female connection points, so make sure to join them correctly.

Step 3: Install your panels

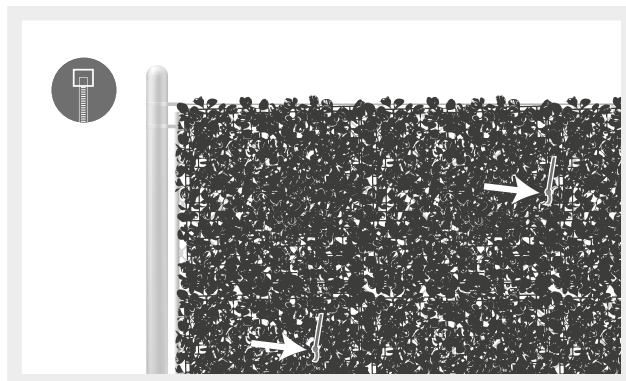
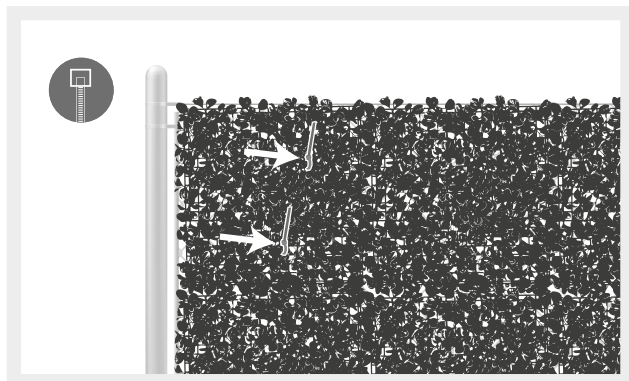


- To begin installing your greenery panels, place the first panel at the top of the metal fence and secure it with plastic zip ties. To prevent the panel from lifting, place additional plastic zip ties at an approximate distance of 10 inches.



- Once the first panel is installed, connect the second panel, and secure it with plastic zip ties. Repeat the procedure until the entire work area is covered.

- With scissors, trim any excess artificial greenery and the extra length of the plastic zip ties.

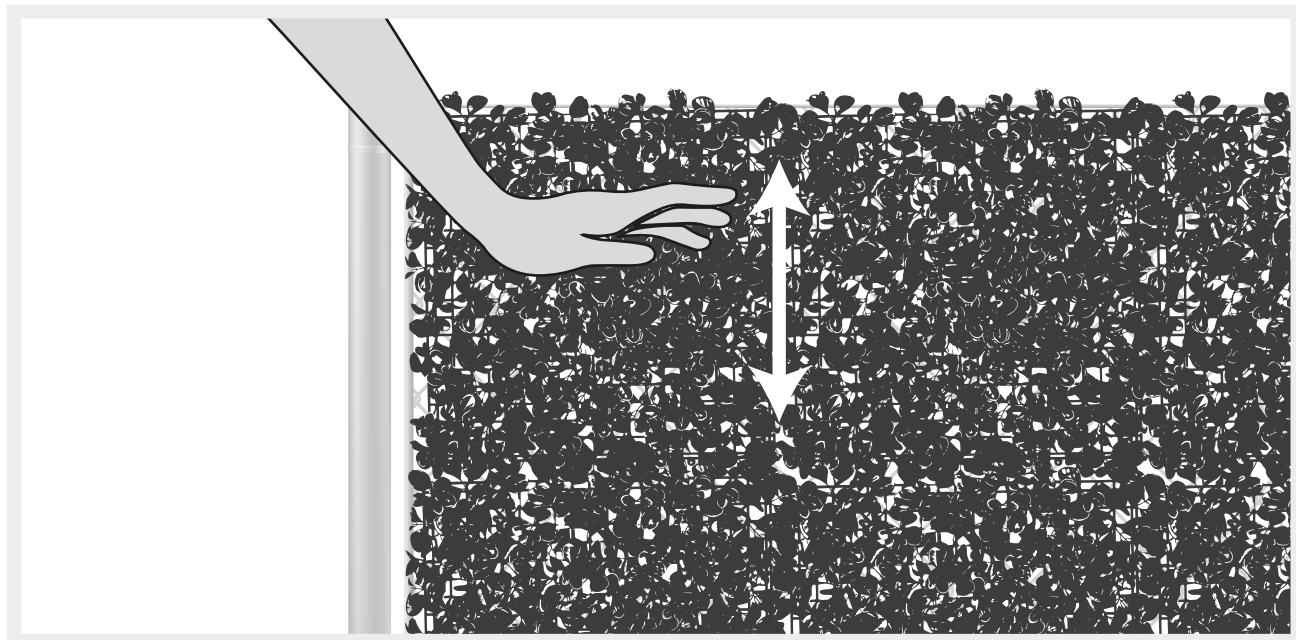


- Ensure the installation is secure by using additional plastic zip ties within artificial greenery. This will prevent the panel from coming loose.



Step 4: Final detail

After completing the installation, run your hands over each panel to open the vegetation, and blend it. This step helps to unify the composition, making it look more realistic and natural.
